List was 33-35 birds depending on whose list you are asking about. We had Savannah and Vesper Sparrows, at least 5 Wilson's Snipe flew around over us. Herons, Egrets, Sandhill Cranes, American Kestrels, Red-shouldered Hawk, Glossy Ibis, Common Yellowthroat.

Nice surprise was some of us seeing 2 Indigo Buntings in winter plumage at the very end of the walk.

We also saw the SpaceX launch going up.

Some new Villagers joined our group for their first walk also.

I didn't get any decent pictures today.

I hope Wendy and those who did will share them with us.
